Duties will include:

- Performing energy audits and inspections using diagnostic equipment such as Blower Door, Duct Blaster, Pressure Pan, CO Analyzer, Infrared Camera, National Energy Audit (NEAT), Mobile Home Energy Audit (MHEA), and REM Design in order to train candidates
- Assistance in development of training design and associated materials
- Research of Building Science and Weatherization best practices
- Assistance in implementation, design, and construction of appropriate training props
- Ensure training and exams meet customer training needs, BPI guidelines, and all requirements as set forth in the training contract with the Virginia Dept of Housing and Community Development.
- Provide technical assistance over the phone

- Good working knowledge of general computer software such as MSWord, Excel, PowerPoint, and an ability and willingness to learn new software
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to handle sensitive situations
